

Policies

Hitting from behind penalties—if a player get a hit from behind in a game, the player will receive a 2 min minor and a game misconduct or a 5 min major and a game misconduct, or a match penalty

2 min minor and game misconduct in the last 10 min of a game means the player will sit the next game to serve the game suspension

5 min major and game misconduct will serve a 1 game suspension

5min major and game misconduct in last 10 min of game will get a 2 game suspension

All suspension must be served in league or sanctioned tournament games, no exhibition games, and must be served with the team the player is rostered with

Not using proper game sheets is \$25 bond per game sheet

AP—In Novice and Atom you can AP up till 11 skaters, not including the goalie

AP—In Pee Wee you can only AP up to 13 skaters, not including the goalie

AP—In Bantam you can AP up to 19(full roster), however there must be a minimum of 6 regular players on the game sheet.

You can only AP up to a higher division (you cannot AP latterly, i.e. bronze to bronze in same division)

You can only AP 5 games to a higher division, after the 6th game the player has to stay with that team (this is only for league play and playoffs. Exhibition games and provincials and tournaments do not count).

All game sheets must be faxed to convenor within 24hrs of game (if incident has occurred in game and a ref report has been filled out, please phone convenor after the game to let him know)

Make sure all refs, timekeepers and scorekeepers have signed the game sheet, and that the names can be read all hits from behind, and major penalties must have a ref report filled out (the game incident report is on the back side of the game sheet)

The refs do not hand out suspensions. The convenors hand out suspensions.

Pee Wee, Atom, and Novice games, please use 2 refs, in Bantam and Midget use 3 refs and female is 2 refs. The refs should be at least 2 years older than the age they are reffing.

No games in Novice can start after 7pm

When league games are rescheduled the convenor must be notified of the date change within 24hrs

Novice, Atom, Pee Wee and Bantam has 2-15 minute periods and 1- 20 minute period with 1 intermission to resurface the ice. (All periods will be stop time)

When a team is losing by 7 goals, the clock will run straight time anytime in the game. All minor penalties will be 2min even in straight time

Midgets will follow high school rules

The home team will supply the pucks for warm up

A game ejection is not the same as a game misconduct; a game ejection is received when you have 3 stick infractions in one game, after 3rd infraction you are ejected for the rest of the game (slashing, high-sticking, crosschecking, spearing, and butt-ending).

With the split season, teams can only cancel 2 games before Christmas and 2 games after Christmas.
